About the Orchestra

The *Newtown Chamber Orchestra* is proud to be among the excellent arts organizations contributing to the rich cultural tradition of Bucks County. Founded by Russell Hoffmann (music director/conductor), Milton Schwartz (concertmaster) and Craig Smith (principal French horn player) in 1990, the Orchestra offers a selection of classical music repertoire suited to small orchestra. The ensemble of professional musicians is joined by local and internationally known soloists to present works from Baroque to Contemporary.

In keeping with its mission to educate and entertain the public in the art of classical music, a speaker introduces performances with relevant music "notes." The Orchestra promotes new chamber works by contemporary composers and encourages young musicians throughout the area.

In addition to its regular performances, the Orchestra performs at sites throughout Bucks County and surrounding areas serving as a guest ensemble for other organizations and for private functions. The Orchestra also hosts:

- Its annual *Young Musicians Competition*, which encourages children in grades 9—12 to showcase their talents and love of music. **Auditions for the Young Musicians Competition February 1, 2009.**
- *Kids Connect to the Classics* which is designed to instill an appreciation for music for younger children and their parents. The Orchestra will present a FREE interactive concert on **March 22, 2009.**

Referred to as "a gem right here in Bucks County," the *Newtown Chamber Orchestra* continues to delight our audience and enhance the life of our community through our commitment to artistic excellence.
